Durham, NC - DeWarren K. Langley has been accepted for admission to the Legal Studies Institute (LSI) of the Fund for American Studies in Washington, DC. and awarded the 2009 Fund for American Studies Scholarship in the amount of \$2,500.00.

A ten-week summer program, LSI combines legal internships, academic coursework for credit, networking opportunities, and career development activities. The Institute will give participants the opportunity to meet and interact with leaders in the legal profession – enabling them to build a valuable professional network as they enter careers in the law.

The first week of the program was dedicated to the academic seminar, the Federalist Understanding of the Constitution. Students will work full time at their legal internships for the remaining nine weeks.

In addition to gaining first-hand exposure to the American legal system, scholarly professionals, and practitioners and to the history of Washington DC, I am enjoying my internship.
